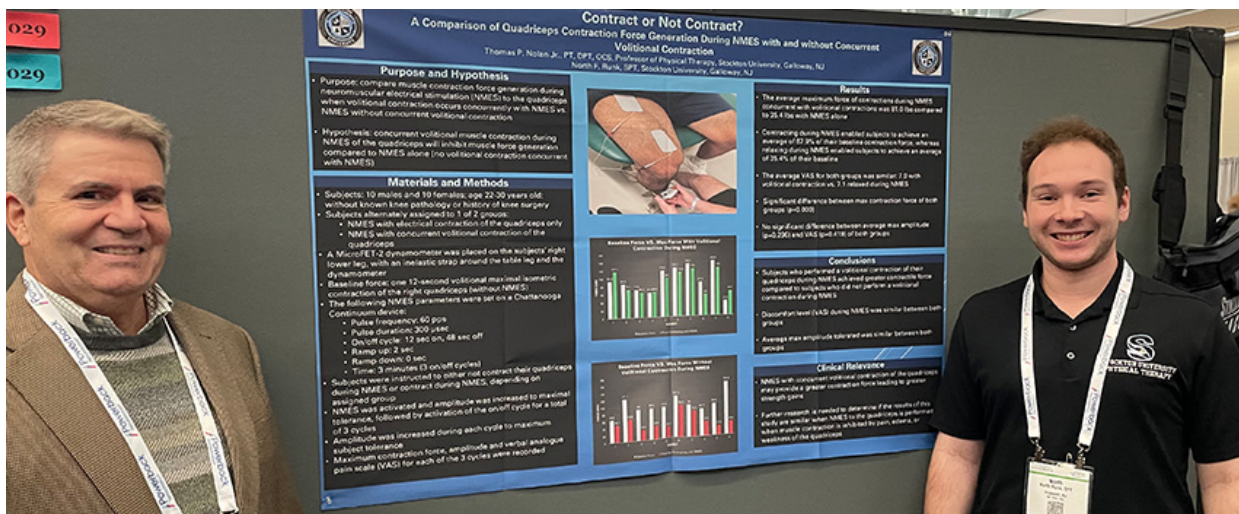


# PROGRAM UPDATES

Eight faculty members and thirty-seven students attended the annual American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) Combined Sections Meeting (CSM) in Boston, Massachusetts from February 14-17, 2024. Dr. Mary Lou Galantino, Distinguished Professor of Physical Therapy, was presented with the Susan J. Mellette Award for Excellence in Leadership in Cancer Rehabilitation by the Academy of Oncology Physical Therapy, the most prestigious award given by the Academy. 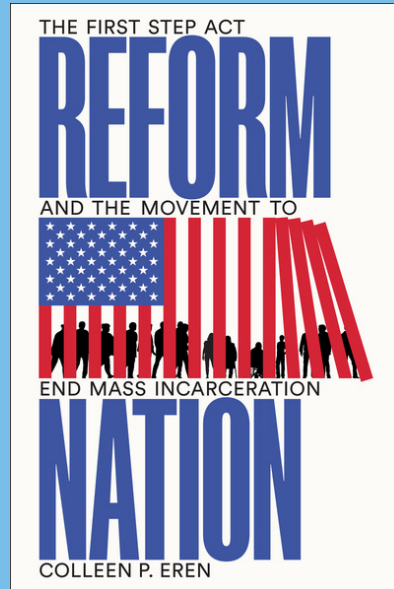

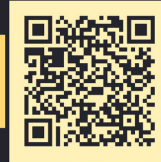
