

Transfer Pathways Memorandum of Understanding Between Ocean County Community College and Stockton University's BS in Social Work

I. Introduction

This is a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between STOCKTON UNIVERSITY (STOCKTON) and OCEAN COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE (OCEAN) to offer opportunities for students to seamlessly pursue Associate and Bachelor of Science in Social Work degrees at two outstanding institutions of higher education.

STOCKTON and OCEAN have agreed on specific program-to-program articulation of courses in order to facilitate the transfer of students into comparable academic majors. Such agreements will be appended to this MOU and reviewed regularly by both schools to ensure they remain up-to-date in terms of course descriptions and degree requirements.


