For all first-year students and transfer students with fewer than 64 credits (B.A. degree), the following are required.

General Arts and Humanities (GAH)	— 8 credits
General Interdisciplinary (GEN)	— 4 credits
General Integration and Synthesis (GIS)*	— 4 credits
General Natural Science and Mathematics (GNM)	— 8 credits
General Social Science (GSS)	— 8 credits

*Must be taken in junior or senior year

No more than 16 credits in any “G” category may be applied toward the B.A. degree.
