Zakiya Smith Ellis, Ed.D, serves as Chief Policy Advisor to Governor Phil Murphy where she is responsible for developing and directing the Governor’s policy initiatives in coordination with the Cabinet.

Previously Dr. Ellis served as New Jersey’s Secretary of Higher Education, where she was responsible for policy development and coordination of higher education activities for the state. In this role, she led the development of a student-focused state plan for higher education featuring a vision for a student bill of rights, the reform of the state’s funding methodology for public institutions of higher education, and the design of the state’s efforts to expand college affordability through tuition-free promises to low-income students.

Prior to her work in New Jersey state government, she led the DC office of Lumina Foundation, the nation’s largest foundation focused solely on higher education. At Lumina she led work to advance federal policy to increase attainment and funded projects to develop new postsecondary finance models, focusing on issues of affordability.

Dr. Ellis has also worked in the Obama administration as a Senior Advisor for Education at the White House Domestic Policy Council and as a senior adviser at the U. S. Department of Education. Earlier in her career she authored reports on the ability of low- and moderate- income students to access, afford, and complete college while on staff at the Advisory Committee on Student Financial Assistance.

Dr. Ellis holds a bachelor’s degree in political science and secondary education from Vanderbilt University, a master’s degree in education policy and management from the Harvard Graduate School of Education, and a doctorate in higher education management from the University of Pennsylvania, where she graduated with distinction for both written dissertation and oral defense.



**Harvey Kesselman, Ed.D.,
President, Stockton University**

Leading under the guiding principle of “students first,” Dr. Harvey Kesselman presides over Stockton University as its fifth President. With beginnings as unique as the university itself, Dr. Kesselman is the only sitting university president to have been in the inaugural class of the very institution he serves.

Throughout Dr. Kesselman’s four-decades-long tenure, he has successfully held leadership positions within virtually every major division of the university, including Provost and Executive Vice President, Interim Vice President for Administration and Finance, Vice President for Student Affairs, and Dean of the School of Education, making him the best-versed ambassador of Stockton University.

At the onset of his presidency, Dr. Kesselman took immediate strides to strengthen the value of a Stockton degree. Under his leadership, the University achieved record-breaking growth in enrollment. Stockton’s enrollment is currently almost 10,000 undergraduate and graduate students.

In keeping with Stockton’s firm commitment to Atlantic City and the surrounding community, President Kesselman negotiated a monumental public-private partnership to build a multi-million dollar state-of-the-art residential campus and parking garage in Atlantic City, which opened in fall 2018. Dr. Kesselman’s visionary prowess and collaborative nature have positioned Stockton University Atlantic City to be not only an extraordinary anchor institution, but a major economic driver for the region and the educational capital of southern New Jersey. In 2018 Atlantic City’s City Council approved the creation of a new University District to support Stockton and help foster economic development in the surrounding neighborhood.

As one of New Jersey’s most prominent and highly regarded educational leaders, Dr. Kesselman’s sphere of influence reaches well beyond the local community. He currently serves as chair of the New Jersey Presidents’ Council (NJPC). He was the co-chair of the student success working group for the NJ State Plan for Higher Education, and also sits on Governor Murphy’s Executive Council for Atlantic City Shared Prosperity. In addition, he has advised the New Jersey College and University Presidents’ Council regarding accountability and assessment, and represented the senior public colleges and universities in the N.J. Committee of Experts on Campus Sexual Assault Issues. In addition, he founded and chaired the SRI & ETTC Consortium, which includes more than 90 school districts throughout New Jersey.

Dr. Kesselman’s efforts in diversity and inclusion have earned Stockton national recognition. Known as a leading authority in public policy on higher education, President Kesselman was appointed by the American Council on Education (ACE) to serve as a member of the Commission on Internationalization and Global Engagement (CIGE).

President Kesselman received his doctorate in Higher Education Administration from Widener University, his master’s degree in Student Personnel Services/Counseling from Rowan University, his bachelor’s degree in Political Science from Stockton, and is a tenured Professor in Stockton’s School of Education, making him the most recognizable alumnus in Stockton’s history.

Stockton University

Stockton University was founded in 1969 as Richard Stockton State College, a public four-year college within the New Jersey system of higher education. A residential institution with students drawn from across the state, Stockton is located at the edge of the New Jersey Pinelands, 12 miles northwest of Atlantic City and 50 miles southeast of Philadelphia. The largest campus in New Jersey, Stockton's award-winning buildings are set within 2,000+ acres of forest, streams, and lakes.

The University first offered instruction in 1971 and currently offers distinctive baccalaureate programs in liberal arts, professional studies, and general education as well as master's and doctoral degree programs designed to stimulate and challenge students intellectually. Stockton is strongly committed to preparing graduates for careers and advanced education, a commitment that encompasses helping students acquire interest in lifelong learning and in contributing to society.

Stockton's faculty members have gained a national reputation for their teaching, accessibility, and scholarship. In addition, faculty members actively mentor students, involving them in original research, hands-on learning, and community engagement. Through academic and co-curricular programming, faculty members guide undergraduate and graduate students to develop their independent and critical thinking skills both inside and outside the classroom.

Stockton University Foundation

The Stockton University Foundation, a non-profit organization founded to support innovative University programs, provides the means for individuals, organizations, and corporations to make gifts, grants, and bequests to the University. This private support enables the University to finance programs not typically funded through State appropriations.

Gifts donated to the Foundation support student scholarships, faculty and student research fellowships, improvements to equipment and facilities, and enrichment of student services and cultural programs. These offerings enhance the University's excellent record recruiting dedicated faculty, retaining students, and engaging friends.

Academic Honors

As part of a comprehensive educational effort to promote and recognize outstanding academic achievement, Stockton University grants baccalaureate degrees with the designations *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *summa cum laude* to qualified graduating students. Those graduates who have achieved academic honors wear a cord around the neck: a gold cord designates *summa cum laude*, a silver cord designates *magna cum laude*, and a white cord designates *cum laude*.

Honors

Students awarded the degree *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, or *summa cum laude* achieve the following eligibility requirements in addition to those needed for a degree. All courses attempted at Stockton are included in the calculations for academic honors, except courses taken as Pass/No Credit. Students must satisfactorily complete at least 64 credits at Stockton prior to graduation in order to qualify for honor's designation.

Students graduate under the policies in effect at the time of their graduation rather than at the time of their initial matriculation. Currently, to receive *summa cum laude* designation, students must achieve a cumulative grade point average of 3.950-4.000; to receive *magna cum laude* designation, students must achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.850-3.949; and to receive *cum laude* designation, students must achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.750-3.849. The calculation of GPA is taken to three decimal places.

Academic Regalia

Academic garb dates back to medieval times, when heavy gowns, hoods, and caps were worn by students to protect them against the cold, dank, and drafty corridors of their universities. In the Middle Ages, Europeans wore clothing of distinctive colors to indicate their status or profession. It was only natural, therefore, that when monks and students began to don distinctive costume for bachelor's (apprentices), master's (teachers), and doctor's (teachers who completed postgraduate study) degrees, the most conspicuous distinctions appeared on the hood.

The academic gowns of the past have been replaced by gowns made of lighter fabric, as students no longer wear them to keep warm and since most commencement ceremonies today take place in the late spring and early summer. Typically, commencement gowns are black, although some institutions have adopted gowns in school colors.

The bachelor's gown, comparatively simple in design, usually has no adornment other than its characteristic long, pointed sleeves. The master's gown has oblong sleeves, which are open at the wrist. The doctor's gown differs from the bachelor's and master's gowns because it sports velvet panels down the front and around the neck and three velvet bands across round, open sleeves.

The bachelor's and master's caps are traditional mortarboard while some doctor's degree caps are a soft, large beret. The tassel, which is usually black for bachelor's and master's degrees, occasionally comes in a color representing the student's field of study and may be gold for doctors and presidents. Prior to conferral of a degree, the tassel falls to the right; upon conferral, students switch the tassel ceremoniously to the left.

The hood, as the most distinctive and symbolic piece of the academic costume, indicates the level of the degree, the field of study, and the institution conferring the degree. The length of the hood denotes the degree; bachelor's hoods are three feet, master's three and a half feet, and doctor's four feet long. There are also similar variations in the length of the velvet trimming. This trimming denotes the field of study for which the degree was awarded. The lining of the hood represents the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree. Some of the colors of the trimming are as follows:

Mace



The origins of the ceremonial mace can be traced to the Middle Ages when knights wielded maces as weapons. As knighthood became obsolete, the mace became symbolic of power. It is now a traditional symbol of authority in churches, government, and universities.

Ned Gerber, Port Republic woodcarver who served on Stockton's founding committee, carved the mace carried by the Faculty Grand Marshal at Stockton graduation ceremonies. The three-foot shaft of the Stockton mace is crafted from walnut and holly, woods indigenous to southern New Jersey. The walnut is from a century-old tree hewn by Tom Lang, a retired member of the Stockton staff. Pewter, the metal employed in Stockton's mace, was a popular and practical metal in New Jersey during colonial times.

Stockton's mace is crowned with the flame of knowledge and carved in holly to denote mission. At the foot is a carved acorn, which indicates growth. Below the flame of knowledge is a triad of Stockton's former logo, a symbol of two trees, denoting environmental concern. Linked edge-to-edge and inlaid with holly, this symbol represents the three populations comprising the University community: students, faculty, and staff. The Great Seal of New Jersey, cast in pewter, signifies Stockton's aegis and sponsorship. A fluted section of walnut below the seal suggests the academic curriculum and the self-discipline necessary for each student to achieve a degree. Below that is a pewter cylinder engraved with the names of the first three Presidents of Stockton University. Finally, an engraved pewter nameplate identifies "Richard Stockton State College founded 1969."

In keeping with the motto "An Environment for Excellence," blue represents the sky. Gold (ink or foil) complements the blue, adds an element of elegance, and emphasizes the value of educational enlightenment.
