While all bachelor programs require a minimum of 128 credits and a 2.00 cumulative GPA, the NJ Department of Education requires a 3.0 cumulative GPA to be certified. Students in this concentration must complete a ARTV major with accompanying EDUC courses as shown. Student must have 30 credits in a coherent sequence in the subject field of ART with 12 credits at the upper level. Candidate must present study in *Drawing, Painting, & Sculpture/Ceramics*. A grade of C or better is required in all content field courses and B- or better in all Teacher Education Program coursework. Consult with the EDUC Program for application and licensure requirements. "The student is responsible for ensuring that all graduation requirements are met" (Bulletin). Consult with your preceptors (EDUC & ARTV) and/or Academic Advising on a regular basis.
