Resolution on Academic Honesty Online Tutorial with e-Verification

Whereas academic dishonesty and plagiarism by students is a concern for faculty, administrators, and students;

Whereas a variety of classes from Freshman to Senior Seminars continually employ pedagogical resources to teach students how to avoid plagiarism, paraphrase, and cite;

Whereas it is pedagogically helpful for faculty to easily determine the extent to which students have already been exposed to tutorials on plagiarism, paraphrasing, and citation;

The Faculty Senate hereby resolves that:

Stockton University adopt an online tutorial system to instruct students on what constitutes academic dishonesty, plagiarism, and how to paraphrase and cite sources with an electronic verification/certificate system which can be accessed by faculty in Banner such as in a student's DegreeWorks. All newly enrolled and readmitted students are required to complete the online tutorial at least once by drop/add of their first semester at Stockton. Those who do not successfully complete the online tutorial by the deadline will have a registration hold placed on their account and will not be able to register for classes.
