What is the projected enrollment?	Once accepted into the dual-degree program, a change of preceptor and major (noting dual degree and concentration) form must be completed. The dual-degree advisor becomes the new preceptor. The dual-degree advisor for the ESPM BS/MBA program is the ESPM program Chair.
	Yes, there are precepting resources available as the HTMS/ESPM program has a Master Advising Blackboard Shell

template that is consistent across all Faculty in the programs. In addition, a supplementary document has been created, titled "ESPM Dual Degree Fact Sheet 2024". This fact sheet is a student Q&A that lists all pertinent information. This form has been modified from the existing dual degree fact sheet and updated to reflect ESPM BSMBA details. In the document, it highlights, that it is imperative that students attend precepting meetings every semester and students are responsible for reading and understanding Degree Works and ensuring that they meet both the course and credit requirements for the program (this is the consistent language used across all dual degree programs in the School of Business). The ESPM program launched Fall 2023 with a total of 14 declared majors as of January 2024. As this is a new program, we are conservatively forecasting 6-10% enrollment in the first year and growth proportionate to enrollment changes per semester.
