2. Ensure academic and student success.

- Identify, evaluate and address the needs of all students; strategic use of data.
- In partnership with Enrollment Management and Student Affairs, implement strategic initiatives to improve student academic success, enrollment, and student retention.
- Successfully complete accreditation reviews resulting in institutional accreditation and program-specific reaffirmation of accreditation.



- 3. Optimize resources for instructional requirements, academic support, facilities, and infrastructure needs of students, faculty, and staff.
- Review, revise and implement processes, practices, and policies for efficient and effective operations; including fiscal management, to prioritize, realign and maximize effective use of resources (budget, personnel, facilities).
- Evaluate academic program viability and vitality through continuous review and improvement. Consider new academic programs to meet market demand and generate new net revenue.
- Develop an inventory of facility improvements to be implemented annually in collaboration with Facilities and Operations.
- Evaluate mission, viability, business models for all Centers and Institutes.
- Plan to consolidate satellite locations, and/or maximize use purpose of each location with an academic presence.



4. Complete the New Strategic Planning Process

- Lead the university-wide strategic planning process to develop a new Strategic Plan for Board of Trustees approval in September 2025.
- Begin to implement recommendations from the Strategic Plan for the Atlantic City campus.



- 5. Ensure Board of Trustees engagement in issues of importance to Academic Affairs.
- Educate Trustees on priorities, challenges, and opportunities across all areas of Academic Affairs.
- Support, promote and celebrate the accomplishments of our students, faculty and staff.
