ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

To be considered for admission to the Master of Arts in Instructional Technology program, applicants must submit the following:

- The online application for graduate admission at www.stockton.edu/grad (including an essay describing relevant experience and reason for pursuing MAIT degree),
- Three letters of recommendation, including form that can be found within the online application,
- Official transcripts from all colleges attended, including baccalaureate degree from regionally accredited institution and minimum grade point average of 3.0 (The applicant with lower than 3.0 GPA needs to submit GRE or MAT, see below)

The GRE or MAT is not required for MAIT program applicants with an undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or above, or for those who already possess a master's degree.

If the applicants do not meet the minimum undergraduate GPA criterion of 3.0, applicants are required to submit GRE or MAT score, which might compensate for lower GPA when applications are reviewed. Also MAIT applicants who would like to pursue a Supervisory Endorsement Program need to submit GRE or MAT score in order to take EDUC supervisory courses. The application review will be conducted holistically, so there is no stated minimum GRE or MAT score.

The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) General Exam (School Code 2889) or Miller Analogies Test scores (MAT) (School Code 1391).
