

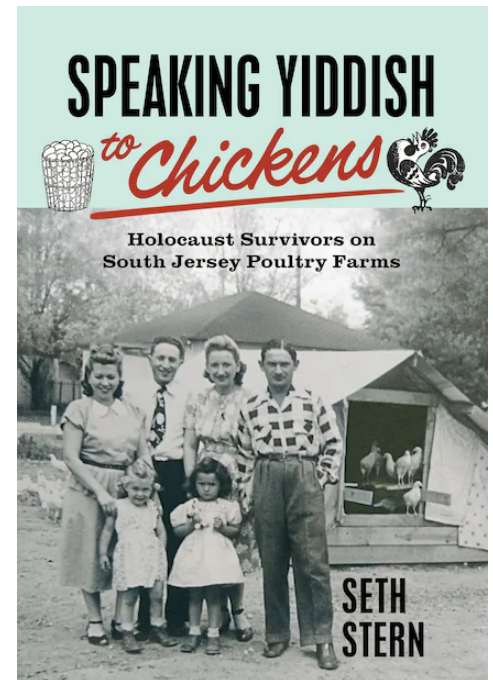
# BOOK DISCUSSION WITH AUTHOR SETH STERN, *SPEAKING YIDDISH TO CHICKENS: HOLOCAUST SURVIVORS ON SOUTH JERSEY POULTRY FARMS*



Seth Stern is a legal journalist and author of *Speaking Yiddish to Chickens: Holocaust Survivors on South Jersey Poultry Farms* (Rutgers University Press, 2023). He is the grandson of Holocaust survivors Betty (Bronia) Sznajdermesser and Nathan (Nuchim) Green (Grin) who settled on a Vineland, New Jersey, chicken farm, which is where his mother grew up.

Stern is an editor at Bloomberg Industry Group and has co-authored *Justice Brennan: Liberal Champion* (Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, 2010) and is a graduate of Harvard Law School.
