Galloway, NJ – The Stockton Center for Community Engagement (SCCE) will host “El Poder del Voto Hispano” – the power of the Hispanic vote – on **Saturday, June 11** at Dante Hall Theater, located at 14 N. Mississippi Ave. in Atlantic City, N.J. from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Members of the community are invited to attend the free event, which will feature various speakers discussing ways Hispanics can become politically and civically engaged.

Assemblywoman Maria Rodriguez-Gregg (R-8) will deliver the keynote address.

“Hispanics are about 20 percent of the New Jersey population,” said Alejandra Londono, an SCCE fellow who organized the event. “They are also the least likely to be registered to vote or civically engaged. It is time to do something about it. It is important for everyone, but especially Hispanics, to understand the power of voting.”

The event will also feature roundtable discussions with elected officials where participants can ask questions about political engagement.

The event is supported by a Stockton University Board of Trustees fellowship, with help from Stockton faculty members Tina Zappile, Jessie Finch and Arnaldo Cordero-Roman.
