Galloway Township, NJ- The Richard Stockton College School of Arts and Humanities presents a spring concert, "Get Your Kicks on Route 66: Ease on Down the Road" on Tuesday, April 30. The concert, at 7:30 p.m., takes place in the Experimental Theatre of the Performing Arts Center (M-Wing) on the Galloway campus.

The event's director, Stockton Professor of Music Dr. Beverly J. Vaughn, said the concert, featuring the Vocal Jazz Ensemble and special guest artists, has a "travel" theme which connects all the songs.
