**Program Specific Notes**

- **Minimum Grade Requirement:** All CRIM courses must be completed with a **C or better**.
- **Capstone Prerequisites:** The following CRIM courses must be completed with a **C or better** before beginning any CRIM 36XX Capstone course: 1100, 2108, 2114, 2121, 2130, 2141, and 2145.
- **Course Modalities:** All CRIM core courses (including capstones) are offered only in **Face-to-Face modality**.
- **Race and Justice Requirement:** Students must complete one course from the following list to satisfy the program's Race and Justice requirement: AFRI 1101/GSS 2201, AFRI 2124, AFRI 2122, AFRI 3150, AFRI 3165, GSS 1092, GSS 2188, GAH 2350, GIS 3190\*, GAH 3206, ANTH 2245, POLS 2245, SOWK 2504. Depending on the course's acronym, credits count toward either cognates, general studies, or at-some-distance.
- **Foundational Cognate:** Students must complete one cognate from the following list to satisfy the program's Foundational Cognate in Social Sciences requirement: SOCY 1100, SOCY 2320, SOCY 2355, SOCY 3636\*, SOCY 3745, SOWK 1101, ECON 1120, ECON 1200, GSS 2264.
