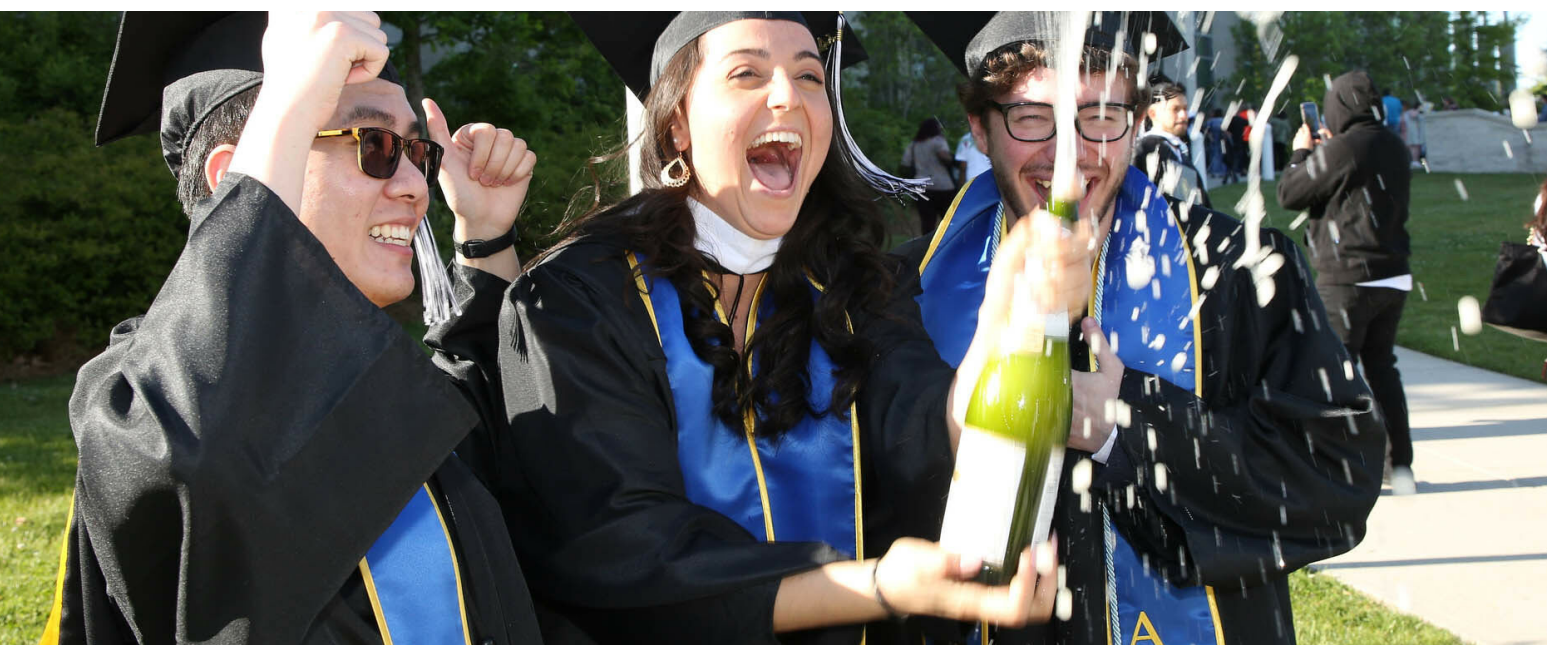

Complete **EXIT Counseling** studentaid.gov

Continuing Students FAFSA Filing Deadline

Time is running out and the state won't wait! If they have not done so already, be sure to **remind your student to complete their 22-23 FAFSA or NJ Alternative Application (NJ Dreamers only) by the April 15 state filing deadline.** Eligible students who do not file by April 15 could miss out on consideration for free money from the State of NJ! This includes funding from programs including the Tuition Aid Grant (TAG), the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) and the new Garden State Guarantee (GSG), which offers eligible students a \$0 net price for tuition and fees.

Remember, the State Won't Wait! File the FAFSA at fafsa.gov. File the NJ Alternative Application (NJ Dreamers only) at hesaa.org. After filing, students can log on to njfams.hesaa.org to view their eligibility for state aid. Questions? Visit stockton.edu/fafsa for more information.
