- 3. If you are transferring from a NJ Community College, check the back of this sheet to see if you took any of the corresponding Education Professional Requirement courses. If a course you completed is not showing on your DegreeWorks audit, let the orientation leader/advisor you are working with know so we do not suggest the same course.
- 4. If you are going to be playing a sport, and are unsure of your practice times, ask an orientation leader for the list of times so you may plan accordingly.
