Re: Intent to terminate Bachelor of Science in Speech Pathology and Audiology program

In accordance with University Procedure 2040: The Life Cycle of Degree Programs, this memorandum conveys the unanimous faculty votes of the Master of Science in Communication Disorders (MSCD) program to terminate the Bachelor of Science in Speech Pathology and Audiology (SPAD) program. At a meeting of the MSCD program on March 25, 2016 faculty voted to cease accepting applications for this program. Dean Bartolotta met with the faculty from the MSCD program to develop a teach-out plan.

There is currently one student remaining in the SPAD program. This student is scheduled to complete her graduation requirements by August 2016. The student has successfully completed all courses in the SPAD major.

In order to inform the higher education community, increase our understanding of trends in academic offerings, and enhance advisement to prospective students, Stockton University will send this notice of intent to terminate a program to its internal and external constituencies.
