Galloway Twp., NJ – The Student Senate Distinguished Lecture Series at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey will present an Evening with Erin Brockovich on Tuesday, March 25 at 7:00 P.M.

Brockovich, subject of the 2000 film starring Julia Roberts, is a former legal clerk who despite a lack of formal law school training was a key figure in building a case against Pacific Gas and Electric Company that would result in the largest settlement amount \$330 million ever paid in a direct action lawsuit in the United States. The case centered around allegations of contaminated drinking water in the California town of Hinkley. She currently is president of her own consulting firm.

As a participant in the Student Senate Distinguished Lecture series, Brockovich joins such luminaries as Spike Lee, Michael Moore and Robert Kennedy, Jr.
